OVERVIEW



HOST CITY MONTERIA CORDOBA COLOMBIA: Monteria, the capital city of the Department of Córdoba, is located in the northwestern part of the country, within Colombia's Caribbean region. Situated on the banks of the Sinú River—hence its nickname "Pearl of the Sinú"—it is also known as the "Cattle Capital of Colombia." The city has a total population of 527,436 inhabitants and an average temperature ranging from 28°C to 32°C

Montería is a cultural city recognized for its traditional folk dances such as cumbia, porro, and fandango, as well as for its handicrafts made from natural fibers, such as the iconic sombrero vueltiao. It is home to major national events such as the corralejas and the National Cattle Fair, both of significant importance in Colombia.

TECHNICAL INFORMATION MEETING:

REGULATIONS: General Regulations of the JEDECAC, Official Rules of the International Amateur Basketball Federation (FIBA).

CATEGORY:

The age of the athletes must comply with the provisions of Article 28 of the General Regulations of the JEDECAC. Maximum age: 17 years old during the year of the competition. Minimum age: 15 years old during the year of the competition.

- Each country may register one (1) team per gender.
- Each team must have two sets of uniforms (one light and one dark).
- For the competition to be official and count toward the medal table, at least three teams from different countries must be registered.

- ❖ Teams may be reinforced with one (1) player from another educational institution, in accordance with Article 27 (section b.1) of the JEDECAC General Regulations.
- Each team will play a minimum of three (3) games per day.
- ❖ Each player must create or verify if they already have a profile at https://play.fiba3x3.com, which must be confirmed and include a photo.

COMPETITION SYSTEM AND TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

The competition system will depend on the number of teams registered in each gender:

- 1. With three (3) teams A double round-robin format will be played, with final standings determined by the highest points obtained.
- 2. With four (4) to six (6) teams A single round-robin will be played. The top four teams in the standings will advance to the semifinals (1st vs. 4th and 2nd vs. 3rd). The winners will play for 1st place, and the losers will play for 3rd place.
- 3. With seven (7) to ten (10) teams Two (2) groups will be formed, each playing a single round-robin. After the group stage, the top team from each group will play for 1st place, while the 2nd-place teams from each group will play for 3rd place.
- 4. With eleven (11) or more teams Groups of 3 or 4 teams will be formed, each playing a single round-robin. The top four teams overall will advance to cross semifinals, with the winners playing for 1st place and the losers for 3rd place.

- 5. In all the above cases, the Technical Coordination of the host country may adjust the competition schedule to ensure that teams play an adequate number of games. This will be determined upon the close of the Nominal Registration.
- b) Each game is played with 3 players on the court and one (1) substitute on the bench.
- c) Game duration is a maximum of 10 minutes, with a scoring limit of 21 points in regular time. If tied at the end of regulation, the first team to score two (2) points in overtime wins the game.
- d) Only for the first game of each competition day, a 15-minute grace period will be granted before the start. If a team fails to appear after this period, they will automatically lose by forfeit.
- e) The official game ball will be the Wilson FIBA 3x3 (#6 synthetic).
- g) Uniforms must be numbered from 04 to 15, displayed visibly on both the front and back.
- h) Points will be awarded as follows:
 - Game won: 2 points
 - Game lost: 1 point
 - Game lost by forfeit: 0 points.
- i) The specific game rules will be followed in accordance with the Official FIBA 3x3 Basketball Rules.

AWARDS

By team:

1st Place - Gold

2nd Place - Silver

3rd Place - Bronze

In addition, a trophy will be awarded to the best athletes by skills, in both genders.

- Overall Scorer
- Two-Point Scorer
- Free Throw Scorer
- Rebounder
- Assist

A trophy will be awarded to the countries finishing in the top three (3) places after determining the overall ranking of the top three (3) places by country:

- Trophy and gold medals for 1st place.
- Trophy and silver medals for 2nd place.
- Trophy and bronze medals for 3rd place.

PROTESTS AND CLAIMS

Article 39: *Eligibility (by age or affiliation to educational institutions)*. Protests regarding an athlete's eligibility before the start of the Games shall be resolved by the JEDECAC Technical Committee for the specific sport discipline. Protests must be signed by the Head of Mission, Deputy Head of Mission, or the corresponding Sport Delegate. To confirm athlete eligibility, all delegations must present the original passports during the technical meetings. All Heads of Mission of the delegations will have access to these documents.

Article 40: The OC (Organizing Committee) and the CT-CONCECADE (Technical Commission of the Central American and Caribbean Sports Council) shall appoint a First Instance Appeals Tribunal for each sport, responsible for reviewing and resolving protests and claims submitted in its respective sport discipline.

This Tribunal will be composed of three (3) persons: the technical coordinator for the sport discipline and two representatives from the participating countries, elected during the informative technical meeting.

TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS

Any matters not provided for in this document shall be resolved by the Organizing Technical Commission of the JEDECAC.
